- The deadline to submit nomination applications for candidates is Thursday, March 17, 2022 (Japan time). Please follow the attached application guidelines and submit application documents to the UNC. We would like to ask that you only nominate candidates who meet all of the eligibility requirements.
  - \*The budget has not yet been finalized, so please begin accepting applications after taking into account the clerical procedures, etc.
  - \*Once the budget has been finalized, we will inform you of the number of participants that will be accepted and the length of the program.
  - \*The recommending organization should select approximately 2 candidates. We will decide the acceptance of applicants after the budget has been finalized.

3. The UNC will conduct an impartial screening of application documents submitted by each organization and accept students after consulting with Okinawa Prefectural Government. Please understand that the candidates nominated by your organization are not guaranteed to be accepted to the program. Furthermore, depending on the situation of the COVID-19 pandemic, the program may be changed or cancelled.

4. Candidates that were nominated for the 2021 academic year program may be re-nominated for the 2022 academic year program. (Copies of documents submitted last year will not be accepted.)
